## **MELANOMA AND SKIN CANCER AWARENESS MONTH**

Whereas: it is imperative that communities across Canada be reminded of the importance of

sun safety; and

Whereas: over-exposure to UV radiation is one of the major causes of melanoma and non-

melanoma skin cancers; and

Whereas: skin cancer is the most common of all cancers. 1 in 6 Canadians born in the 1990's

will get skin cancer in their lifetimes; and

Whereas: many people seek sun without taking the advisable precautionary measures and

are unaware that any darkening of skin color, including a tan, is indicative of UV

damage; and

Whereas: skin self-examinations should be performed on a monthly basis because skin

cancers are highly treatable when detected early; and

cancers, melanoma and ocular melanoma through nationwide education, advocacy

and awareness initiatives.
