over-exposure to UV radiation is one of the major causes of melanoma

and non-melanoma skin cancers; and

skin cancer is the most common of all cancers. 1 in 6 Canadians born in

the 1990s will get skin cancer in their lifetimes; and

WHEREAS

many people seek sun without taking the advisable precautionary measures and are unaware that any darkening of skin colour, including

a tan, is indicative of UV damage; and

WHEREAS

skin self-examinations should be performed on a monthly basis because skin cancers are highly treatable when detected early; and

nationwide education, advocacy, and awareness initiatives;
