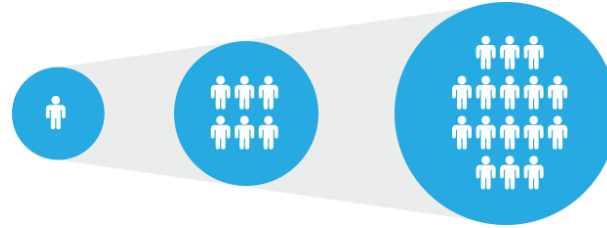

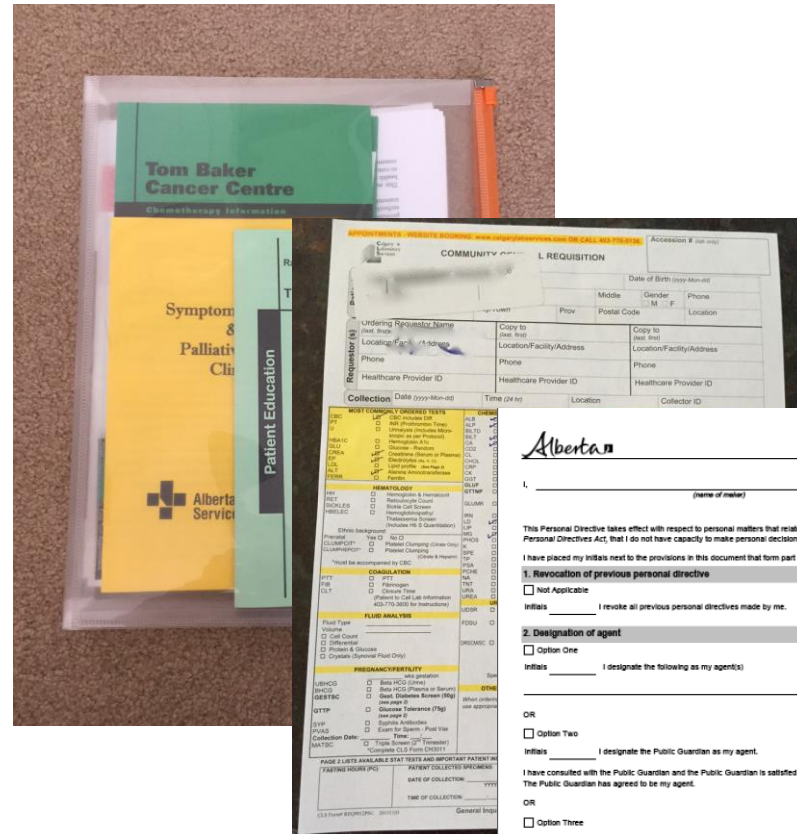

ASCO 2017, Dr. Basch

Website application providing email alerts to nurses & printed report of symptoms for oncologist visit.

- 766 patients, average age, 62
- 7% drop in ER visits
- 31% improved QOL
- 50% increase in reported symptoms
- 5 months increase in OS
- Technology was not a barrier!
