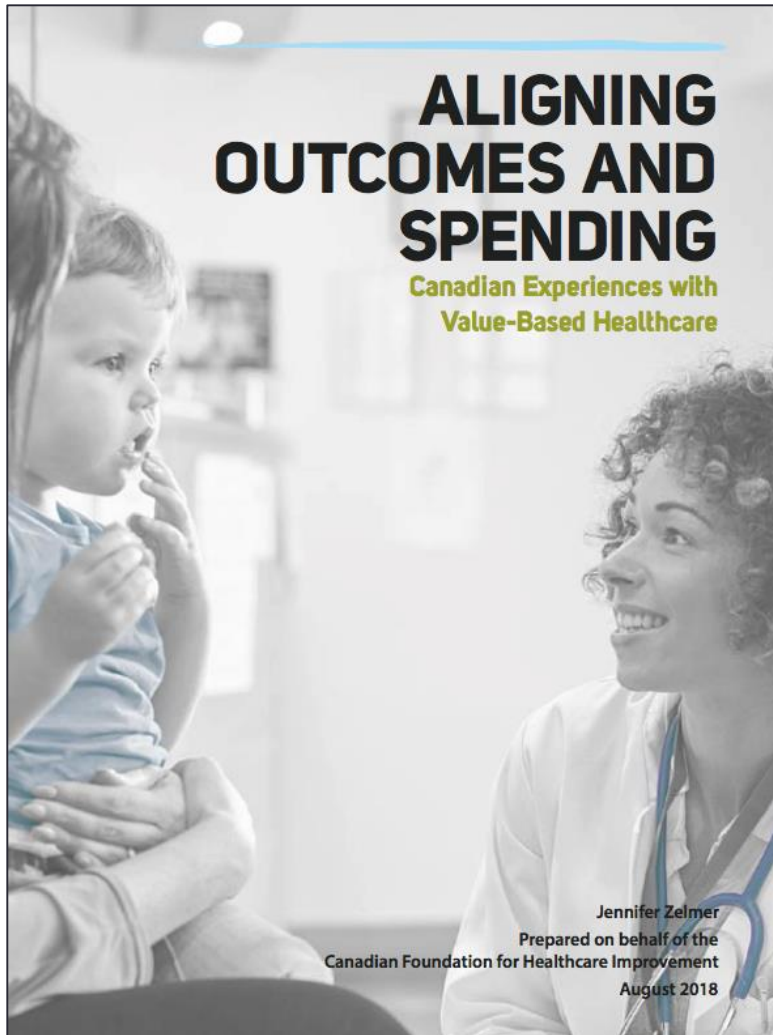

Value is defined as the outcomes that matter to patients, divided by the costs to achieve those outcomes

Value will vary among different **population segments** (e.g. demographic groups, patients with certain diagnoses)

Value will vary among patients who receive different **interventions** (e.g. treatments)



Value = Outcomes (including clinician- and patient-reported measures) divided by costs



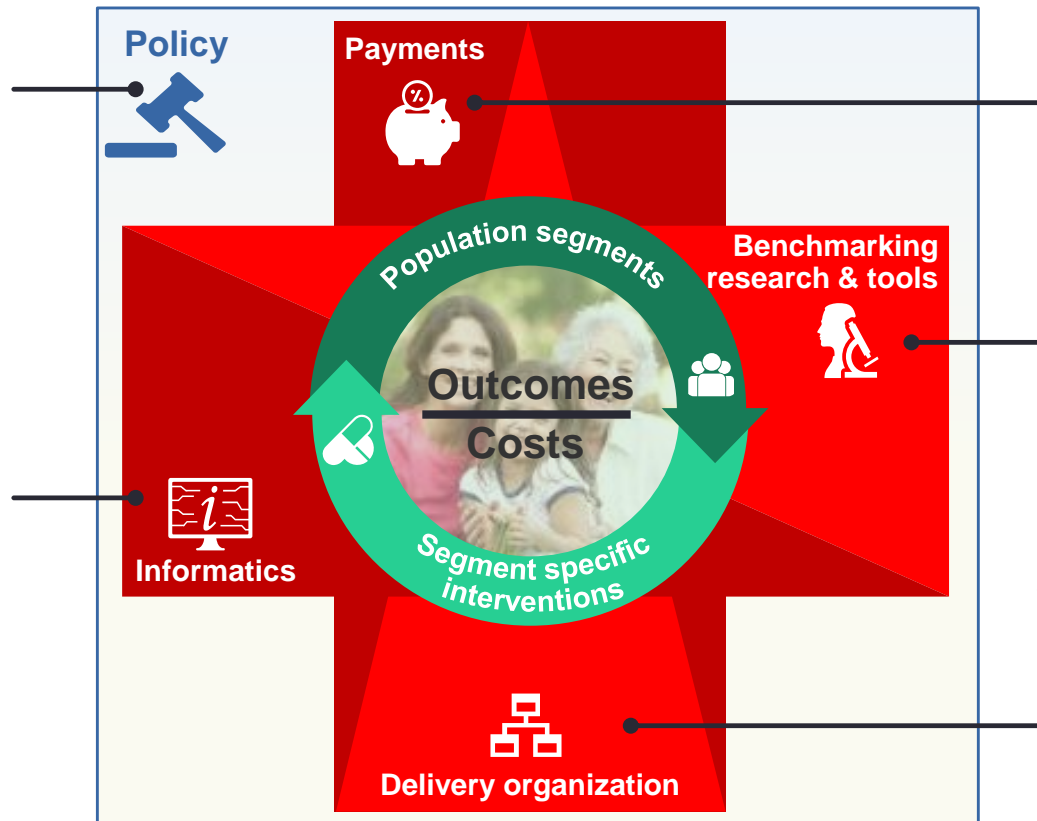

Value-based systems take a data-driven approach to deliver value for patients

Policies and regulation that support learning and continuous improvement **based on a data-driven approach**

Informatics that **permits capture, analysis and sharing of health outcomes and relevant data** for each population segment



Payments that **use data on outcomes** to reimburse for value, rather than volume of care

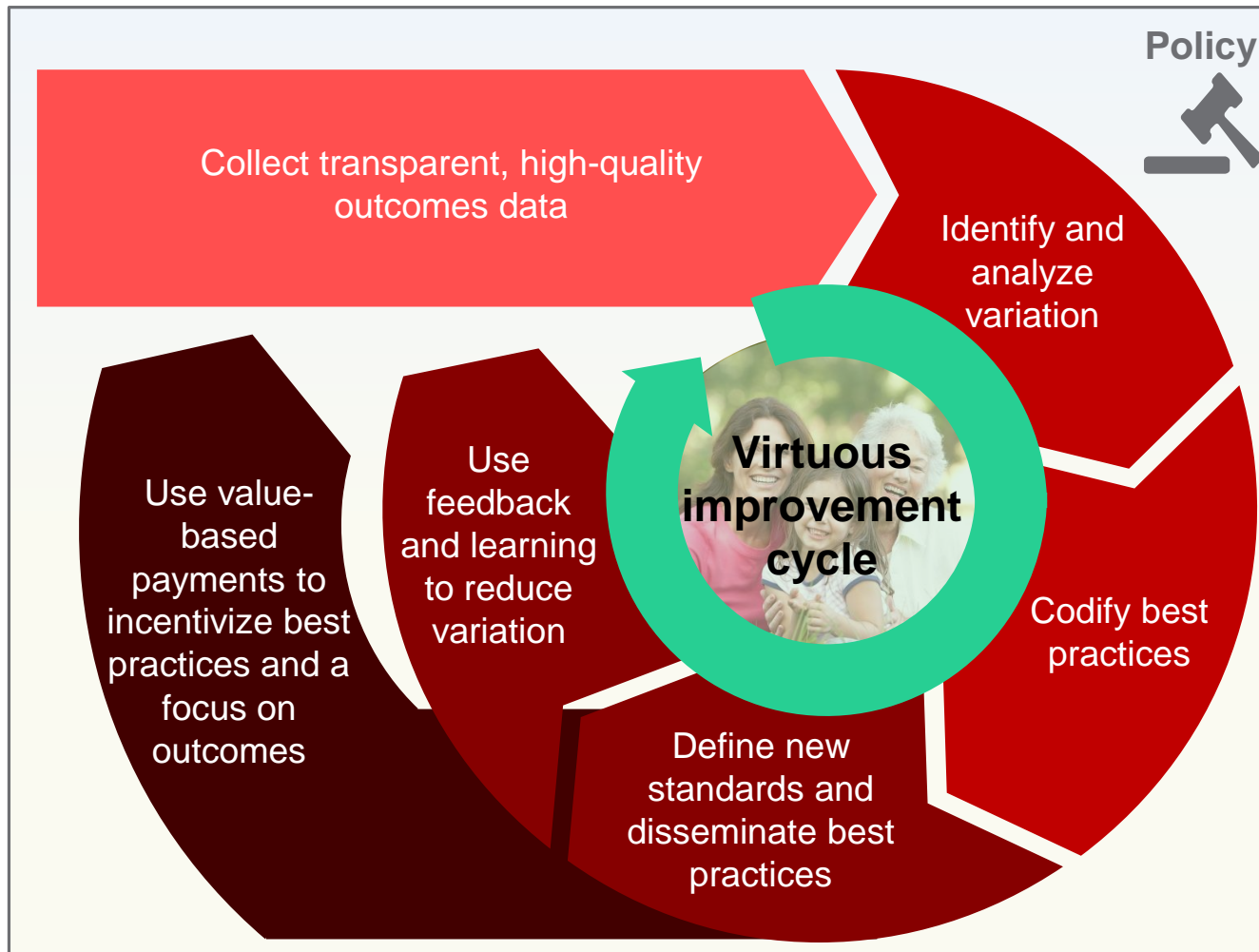
Tools to analyze data and generate insights for benchmarking, research and decision-support for clinicians, patients and innovators

Organizational models that enable better access to care, ensure continuous improvement, and **measure performance** of integrated care pathways
