

## Proclamation

## MELANOMA AWARENESS MONTH May 2020

Whereas: it is imperative that communities across Canada be reminded of the importance

of sun safety; and

**Whereas:** over-exposure to UV radiation is one of the major causes of melanoma and non-

melanoma skin cancers; and

**Whereas:** skin cancer is the most common of all cancers (1 in 6 Canadians born in the

1990s will have skin cancer in their lifetimes); and

Whereas: many people seek sun without taking the advisable precautionary measures and

are unaware that any darkening of skin colour, including a tan, is indicative of UV

damage: and

Whereas: skin self-examinations should be performed on a monthly basis because skin

cancers are highly treatable when detected early; and

Whereas: Save Your Skin Foundation is dedicated to the fight against non-melanoma skin

cancers, melanoma and ocular melanoma through nationwide education,

advocacy and awareness initiatives.
